SOCIAL DISTANCING POLICY



As our country faces the growing pandemic and threats resulting from the Coronavirus and the associated COVID-19 disease, Nelson & Associates, Inc. is taking appropriate steps to stop or slow the spread of the virus and protect the individuals and families we serve, our staff and our communities.

Effective 3/16/2020, Nelson will close all offices to the general public for the next 30 days. First and foremost, we want to maintain a safe community. We ask all residents and staff to cooperate in taking steps to reduce the transmission of infectious diseases, including the coronavirus. Residents and staff are reminded of the following:

- Stay home when sick and avoid close contact with others.

- Recertifications and move ins are suspended for 30 days to avoid personal interaction.
- All maintenance personnel must wear gloves and or mask
- Maintenance will use this time to concentrate on out- door projects and vacant units.
- Parents of school age children that are now home due to shut down, may be permitted to work from home if necessary.
- Corporate travel is suspended, and all employees must notify the corporate office of any travel and if you have travelled to an affected area and/or have symptoms.

For the health and safety of our residents and staff we ask that you avoid the leasing office, community common areas, and placing non-emergency maintenance requests.
